As part of this, we want to make our key principles, across a number of areas, clear and accessible to all so everyone can appreciate what we stand for.

Scope

All chicken meat procured by Greggs.

Key Principles

- Must originate from broiler chickens that must:
 - Be cage free
 - Be reared in conditions which are compliant with EU and source country FAW legislation
 - Maximum stocking density of 30Kg M2 for Thai supply and 38Kg for all other sources.
 - By 2026 all supply to comply with the requirements of the European Chicken Commitment (ECC) including a maximum stocking density of 30Kg M2
 - Comply with our published FAW strategy.
